

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy ("**Privacy Policy**" or "**Policy**") was developed by **PROSPECTIVA PARTICIPAÇÕES LTDA.**, a limited liability company, registered with the tax identification number under CNPJ No. 04.156.392/0001-33, headquartered at Avenida Brigadeiro Faria Lima, No. 201, Pinheiros, in the city of São Paulo/SP, Brazil 05426-100 (hereinafter, together with its affiliates and subsidiaries, referred to as "**Prospectiva**") in order to inform and clarify to the User the general rules for collection, use, storage, processing, protecting, sharing, and deleting Personal Data relating to the use of Prospectiva's website available through the URL www.prospectiva.com ("**Website**"). Terms not defined in this Policy shall have the meaning given in the Terms and Conditions of Use available on the Website.

1. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED BY PROSPECTIVA

1.1. Register to receive the Newsletter: Prospectiva receives and stores the e-mail address provided by the User when registering to receive the Newsletter, as stated in Clause 3 of the Terms and Conditions of Use of the Website.

1.2. Browsing Data: Prospectiva may also automatically collect browsing information such as the internet protocol (IP) address used to connect the User's computer to the internet, geographic location, browser type, date, time and duration of browsing, and logs.

2. PURPOSE OF USE OF PERSONAL DATA

2.1. Register to receive the Newsletter: The collected email address will be used for the purpose of sending a periodic newsletter with news and updates on topics of interest dealt with on the Website, including advertising material for Prospectiva. In addition, Prospectiva may use email addresses to develop business with potential customers, including, but not limited to, scheduling meetings and sending commercial proposals.

2.2. Browsing Data: This information may be used by Prospectiva to understand and analyze trends, manage the Website, assess the behavior of Users, and obtain general geographic information about Users. Prospectiva may also use this information for

purposes of security and improvements to the Website, as well as for marketing and advertising services.

2.3. Processing Personal Data for purposes not provided for in this Privacy Policy will only occur upon prior notice to the User, and, in any case, the rights and obligations set forth herein will remain applicable.

3. PERSONAL DATA STORAGE TIME

3.1. Prospectiva stores Personal Data for the necessary time for the purposes for which the data was collected and for the purposes set out in the Terms and in this Privacy Policy, respecting the data retention period determined by applicable law.

3.2. The User may at any time request the deletion of their Personal Data, by sending an email to: privacidade@prospectiva.com.

4. STORAGE METHOD OF PERSONAL DATA AND SECURITY

4.1. Personal Data shall be stored in operating environments that use reasonable security standards to prevent damage from occurring, as well as prevent unauthorized access to data. In the event of failures, viruses and/or invasions of Prospectiva's database ("**Security Incident**"), Prospectiva will notify Users and take appropriate measures, pursuant to the Brazilian General Data Protection Law ("**LGPD**").

4.2. Prospectiva undertakes to apply technical and organizational measures to protect Personal Data from unauthorized access and from situations of destruction, loss, alteration, communication, or dissemination of such data.

5. INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFER

5.1. The User acknowledges and agrees by giving his or her consent to the processing of his/her Personal Data that Prospectiva may carry out the international transfer of data, under the terms of the LGPD, in order to provide the functionalities available on the Website.

6. RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF USERS

6.1. The User, holder of Personal Data, at any time and free of charge, may exercise the following rights:

- a. Access: when choosing to exercise the right of access, the User will see the data about him or her that Prospectiva processes and will be able to access them.
- b. Portability: when choosing to exercise the portability right, the User will receive a report of the Personal Data about him or her that Prospectiva processes to share with any third party he or she wishes.
- c. Correction/Update: The User's Personal Data must be accurate and will be corrected and/or updated whenever necessary, so that inaccurate data is erased or corrected when possible.
- d. Explanation: the User may choose to receive information about the origin, purpose, and form of data treatment, as well as possible sharing with third parties.
- e. Deletion, anonymization, and blocking: the User may request the deletion, anonymization or blocking of unnecessary, excessive data, or data processed in violation of the provisions of the LGPD.
- f. Withdrawal of consent: the User may obtain explanations about consent (consent given for the collection and processing of his or her data) and revoke it.
- g. Newsletter Receipt Preferences: the User may exercise the right to continue or not to receive newsletters, communications of promotional campaigns, and/or offers of products and services from Prospectiva.

6.2. In order to exercise any of these rights, the User must contact Prospectiva by email at privacidade@prospectiva.com.

6.3. It is the sole responsibility of the User to insert only true information on the Website.

7. CONSENT TO THE PRIVACY POLICY:

7.1. By accessing and using the Website, the User is consenting to this Privacy Policy.

7.2. The User has the right to withdraw his or her consent at any time, without compromising the lawfulness of the processing of his Personal Data prior to withdrawal.

8. CHANGES TO THE PRIVACY POLICY

8.1. The present version of this Privacy Policy was last updated on May 20, 2021.

8.2. Prospectiva reserves the right to modify this Privacy Policy at any time, keeping it updated and available on the Website www.prospectiva.com. The User must periodically and completely read this Privacy Policy. If he or she disagrees with any of the changes, the User must immediately notify Prospectiva of his or her disagreement with the aforementioned update, state the withdrawal of his or her consent to the processing of Personal Data and request the deletion of such data.

9. APPLICABLE LAW AND JURISDICTION

9.1. This instrument and any obligations of a non-contractual nature arising hereunder or thereunder, shall be governed, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of Brazil (excluding any conflicts of laws, rules or principles that may refer such interpretation to the laws of another jurisdiction), and this instrument shall be treated in all respects as an agreement signed under such jurisdiction.

9.2. Any disputes must be submitted to the courts of the district of São Paulo/SP.
